

TERMS & CONDITIONS 2020

Please ensure you have read and understood the Terms and Conditions for The Big Virtual Cycle. You will confirm you read and understood these before completing your booking.

- 1. The 2020 The Big Virtual Cycle (henceforth known as the 'event') will take place between 22 May 2020 and 31 August 2020. The event is organised by Weston Hospicecare (henceforth known as the 'event organisers') and will be a virtual event, taking place in locations globally.
- 2. The event is a fundraising event for Weston Hospicecare (registered charity number: 900328). The entry fee helps to cover the cost of organising the event. Therefore, participants are strongly encouraged to raise sponsorship money or make a personal donation.
- 3. We ask that you return all of your sponsorship and donations to by Saturday 31 October 2020.
- **4.** The registration fee is strictly non-refundable. If the event is cancelled or postponed due to unforeseen circumstances out of the hospice's control the event registration fees are non-refundable.
- 5. To qualify for your finisher medal you must submit evidence in the form of a screen shot of the distance cycled recorded by a phone app or smart watch or photo of distance on electric bike to: grace.dibden@westonhospice.org.uk.
- 6. The event must take place over 30 consecutive days between 22 May and 31 August 2020.
- 7. How the distance is covered is not limited, any pace or regularity is permitted.
- 8. The medals:

FAMILY/BEGINNER: Gold: 75 miles, Silver: 50 miles, Bronze: 30 miles ADVANCED: Gold: 600 miles, Silver: 400 miles, Bronze: 200 miles.

- 9. The medals will be ordered by the event organisers at the end of the event (August 2020) and you will receive your medal after this point, no matter when the event is completed by you. Please be aware that due to the COVID-19 situation, medal production may be delayed and you will be kept updated on when to expect your medal.
- 10. Any participant who is aged under 18 years old must be accompanied by an appropriate adult when undertaking the challenge.
- 11. The event organisers reserve the right to remove any participant reported for exhibiting any antisocial behaviour towards other participants, and / or members of the public at any point during the challenge from the event, they will not receive their finisher medal.
- 12. A thorough risk assessment is completed by the event organisers in advance of the event.
- 13. Weston Hospicecare nor any of its employees, accepts liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to any persons or animals in any way whatsoever throughout the event.
- 14. All participants will be taking part at their own risk and are asked to take care when taking part in the event and ensure they are equipped with suitable provisions, clothing and physical ability.
- 15. You understand that Weston Hospicecare cannot be held responsible for any illness or injury sustained during a period of training for the event, or during the event itself, and that you enter and intend on participating at entirely your own risk.
- 16. You have chosen to enter The Big Virtual Cycle of you own choice and confirm that your general state of health and fitness is good, and any injury sustained during the event or whilst training is your own responsibility and will not be the responsibility of the event organisers.
- 17. We ask all participants to adhere to all government guidelines on the COVID-19 social distancing and lockdown regulations. Weston Hospicecare does not give permission to any participant to not adhere to these, for example, safe distancing of those around you by at least 2 meters.
- 18. Weston Hospicecare is authorised to use any photo submitted to us via email to any address ending in @westonhospicecare.org.uk for marketing purposes. Having completed your entry form, you are deemed as accepting that your photograph and any footage you appear in may be used in future hospice advertising or local press materials.
