# FAQs

**What is the Men's March?** The Men's March is a 10 mile sponsored walk just for men! On your return, you will be welcomed back and given your exclusive 'watch the match at home' goodie bag

**How much is it?** Tickets cost £18.50 for adults and £12.50 for children. A limited number of cheaper early bird tickets are available until 31 January or until they sell out.

**Where does it start?** The event starts and finishes at Weston-super-Mare Cricket Club, the outdoor setting ensure social distancing is possible throughout the event. The route takes you through Uphill, along the seafront and up to Weston woods and back. This is approximately 10 miles.

**When is it?** Saturday 20 March. You will be given a start time one week before the event, starting from 8:30am. You will need to arrive ready to start your walk at this time. You will be in small groups set off at safe time intervals to avoid large gatherings of people.

**Will we be watching the Six Nations match together again like last year?** Due to COVID-19 guidelines we are unable to invite you all to watch the match together on the big screen this year. You will be able to take your exclusive 'watch the match at home' goodie bag back with you to settle down and watch the decisive England v Ireland Six Nations match in the comfort of your own home.



### What do I get for the registration fee?

- Entry to the 10 mile walk
- Back walkers, support vehicles, marshals and first aid cover
- Goodie bag with a snack, sweets and:

**When is the deadline for registration?** The deadline for registration is 11:59pm on Sunday 14 March. We will not be having on the day sign ups this year.

**What is the minimum age?** There is no minimum age limit to take part in the event. Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult, who is also taking part in the event.

**Can women do the walk?** Unfortunately, no. We do however have a women's only event, the Moonlight Beach Walk, on Friday 17 September 2021 so check out our website for more details. We also need lots of volunteers for the Men's March, so women are welcome to be part of the event by volunteering. **Is bag storage available?** No, there will not be bag storage available at the event.

**Are there toilets on site?** Yes; there will be toilets at the Cricket Club.

**Does my entry fee act as a donation to Weston Hospicecare?** No, your entry only covers the cost of organising the event. We ask you to raise as much money as possible to support the work of Weston Hospicecare. It is your sponsorship and fundraising efforts that go to the hospice, helping us care for local people affected by cancer and other life-limiting illnesses.

**Is there wheelchair access?** Sections of the route are on the beach and in Weston Woods and therefore the route is not suitable for wheelchairs. We apologise for any inconvenience.

**What should I wear?** Please wear appropriate clothing for the weather. Wearing layers of clothing that can gradually be removed or replaced as your body temperature changes will help.

**Where can I park / how do I get there?** There is free parking at the Cricket Club. The postcode is BS23 4NY and the Club can be accessed off Windwhistle Lane from the A370.
