



MEN'S MARCH

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Please ensure you have read and understood the Terms and Conditions for Men's March. You will have confirmed you read and understood these before completing your booking.

1. The 2021 Men's March (henceforth known as the 'event') will be held on Saturday 20 March 2021 (henceforth known as the 'event day'). The event is organised by Weston Hospicecare (henceforth known as the 'event organisers') and will start at Weston-super-Mare Cricket Club (Devonshire Road, BS23 4NY) (henceforth known as 'event HQ').
2. The event is a fundraising event for Weston Hospicecare (registered charity number: 900328). Your entry fee helps to cover the cost of organising the event. Therefore, you are strongly encouraged to raise sponsorship money or make a personal donation.
3. Weston Hospicecare ask that you return all of your sponsorship and personal donations by Friday 30 May 2021.
4. The registration fee is strictly non-refundable. If the event is cancelled or postponed due to unforeseen circumstances out of the hospice's control (such as unsafe weather conditions), the event registration fees are strictly non-refundable.
5. You will receive your start time one week before the event. You must arrive ready to start walking at this time. You will be in small groups, set off at safe time intervals to avoid large gatherings of people in line with COVID-19 guidelines. Your group will include all other participants with whom you registered.
6. You must arrive promptly for your start time, no more than ten minutes either side of the time. If you arrive early, you will be asked to leave event HQ until your walking time. If you are late, you will not be able to walk.
7. You must register on event day at the event HQ. You may not start from any other point along the route. This applies to all participants.
8. You must de-register at the event HQ as soon as you finish the walk, failure to do so will result in your emergency contact being contacted, if the event organisers cannot confirm that you have safely finished the route the emergency services will be notified and a search party may be mobilised.
9. There will be no 'bag drop' at event HQ and the event organisers shall not be liable in respect of any loss or damage whatsoever to participant belongings.
10. You will receive a participant number that must be pinned onto your front throughout the event. For your personal safety, you are not permitted to swap this number or allow anyone else to use your number.
11. Any participant who is aged under 18 years old must be accompanied by an appropriate adult who is also registered for the event and agrees to take part with the younger participant at all times. The adult is responsible for registering the

participant that is under 18 and must take full responsibility for both of their participation and safety.

12. Any participant undertaking any illegal activities or exhibiting any anti-social behaviour towards other participants, volunteers, staff and / or members of the public at any point during the event will be asked to leave the event immediately.
13. To capture the excitement on the event there will be professional photographers and videographers at the event taking photos and recording footage, some of which will be used for publicity purposes. Having completed your entry form, you accept that your photograph and any footage you appear in may be used in future hospice advertising or local press materials.
14. The cut off time for participants on the course is strictly 6pm, upon which any outstanding walkers will be guided off the course.
15. If you are unable to complete the event after registration you must inform a marshal on route or let event HQ know. If you fail to do this, you may be presumed missing and emergency services may be called out to locate you.
16. You are responsible for the appropriate disposal of all rubbish you create along the route.
17. If you are bringing a dog to the event, you hold full responsibility for clearing away and disposing of any dog waste during the event. You understand you are liable to any fines imposed by the local council if you do not clear up all dog waste.
18. There are no 'return lifts' available via support vehicle should you choose to drop out or be injured. You should call 999 for all emergencies.
19. The event organisers in advance of the event complete a thorough risk assessment. Qualified first aiders, volunteer back walkers and hired 4x4 rescue teams will be roaming the course.
20. All participants will be taking part at their own risk and advised to take care when at the event and ensure they are equipped with suitable provisions, clothing and physical ability.
21. You understand that Weston Hospicecare nor any of its employees, accepts liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to any persons or animals in any way whatsoever sustained during a period of training for the event, or during the event itself, and that you enter and intend on participating at entirely your own risk.
22. Route marshals are not responsible for your safety at any time; they are only to give advice on route direction. Your safety crossing roads etc. is your personal responsibility.
23. You have chosen to enter the 2021 Men's March of your own choice and confirm that your general state of health and fitness is good, and any injury sustained during the event or whilst training is your own responsibility and will not be the responsibility of the event organisers.
24. If at any point within two weeks of the event day you are displaying signs of COVID-19 or you have been diagnosed with it, you must not participate in the event.
25. The event organisers have and will take steps to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19 at the event, by signing up you confirm that you will follow all event rules and are participating at your own risk.
26. You must socially distance from everyone outside of your bubble at the event, this is your personal responsibility and you agree to abide by the government guidelines of this at the time of the event day.
