



MEN'S MARCH 2022 TERMS & CONDITIONS

Before completing your registration, please ensure you have read and understood the Terms and Conditions for the Men's March. You will not be able to complete your entry unless you confirm you have read and understood these.

1. This is a fundraising event for Weston Hospicecare (Registered Charity Number: 900328). Your entry fee only covers the cost of organising the event. Therefore, you are strongly encouraged either to raise sponsorship money or make a donation to the event.
2. You must register at the Regency Suite at the Grand Pier (BS23 1AL). You may not start from any other location. This applies to all participants.
3. All participants must complete an official Weston Hospicecare Men's March 2022 registration form in advance of the event; this can be completed offline at Weston Hospicecare or online on the official website. Please note that registration for the Men's March is ONLY open to men. The closing date for completing your registration is Sunday 6th March 2022.
4. At the discretion of the event organisers: an 'on the day' sign up policy may be initiated – this 'on the day' fee would be applicable from the date registrations close. However, this is entirely dependent on the total number of existing participants and an increased entry fee will apply to both adults and children tickets. There is no guarantee implied that an entry place will be available to those who turn up 'on the day'.
5. On the day, you will be given a numbered participant wristband at the registration desk when signing in. For your personal safety, you are not permitted to swap this number or allow anyone else to use your number. You must wear this throughout the event and returned to the Grand Pier upon deregistration.
6. The cut off time for participants on the course is strictly 6pm, upon which any outstanding walkers will be guided off the course.

7. Any participant who is aged under 18 years old must be accompanied by an appropriate adult (over the age of 18) who is also registered for the event and agrees to accompany the younger participant at all times. The adult is responsible for registering the participant who is under 18 and must take full responsibility for both of their participation and safety.

8. On the day, if you are unable to complete the challenge it is essential that you either inform a marshal on the route or call 07514 666955. If you fail to do this, you will be presumed missing and emergency services may be called out to locate you.

9. Upon completion of the walk and return to the Grand Pier, walkers will each receive a pint of Thatcher's Cider, a pasty, and a souvenir pint glass. Please note that adult walkers may take a soft drink instead of cider – all participants aged 17 or under (and those unable to prove they are 18 or above) will automatically receive a soft drink.

10. We ask that you return all of your sponsorship, or any personal donations, by Friday 13 May 2022. By doing so, Weston Hospicecare can make sure that we are on target to achieve best possible care to those who need it. Please do not bring any sponsorship money or personal donations with you on the day of the event.

11. A thorough risk assessment is completed by the event manager in advance of the event. Qualified first aiders and back walkers will be roaming the course. If you do suffer an injury or loss during this event, Weston Hospicecare and any of the associated sponsors will not be held responsible. All participants will be taking part at their own risk and are asked to take care when at the event and ensure they are equipped with suitable provisions, clothing and physical ability. There are no 'return lifts' available via support vehicle should you choose to drop out or get injured. You should call 999 for emergencies or 07912 755752 for first aid.

12. If the event is cancelled or postponed due to unforeseen circumstances out of the hospice's control (such as unsafe weather conditions) the event registration fees are non-refundable.

13. To capture the excitement of the event we will have professional photographers and videographers capturing the event. Some of which may be used for publicity purposes. By completing your entry form, you are deemed as accepting that you may appear in the event video and could appear in promotional materials in the future. In addition, your photograph may be used in future hospice advertising or local press materials.
